CAT: cat & cats; GO: go, goes, going, gone, (went?)

- Table 15: N/V/A into N/V/A; P not featured
- stem: form with inflections removed =/=
- root: smallest morphological form associated with the lexeme
- two grammatical/morphosyntactic words of the
 word form **cross-ed** = past OR past participle
- lexeme **CROSS** →
 word forms **cross, crosses, crossing, crossed** →
 grammatical words **crossed¹ vs crossed²**
- lexical entry: **WALK** (i) mng (ii) syntax (iii) pronunciation
- **KNIFE** has two stems:
 singular /naɪf/ & pl /naɪv/ – to which plural suffix /z/ is added
